<u>DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO AMEND CONTRACT WITH VECTOR CONTROL CONSULTANTS FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES</u>

Cramer motioned, seconded by Ray, increase contract compensation amount with Vector Control Consultants by \$18,000 due to the addition of a document to be created for resource agencies and wetlands consultants concerning mosquito prevention guidelines and best management practice for tidal and managed tidal wetlands. Motion passed unanimously.

-Member Valentine requested a District presentation at a Calistoga city council meeting in 2020.

MANAGER'S REPORT

- -There were 39 service calls for the month of September. District technicians are staying "on-top" of marsh mosquitoes.
- -District Manager advised that there will be an increase in legal bills as he has been in constant contact with attorneys requesting advice and guidance regarding the draft Lake and Stream Bed Alteration Agreement with California Department of Fish and Wildlife.
