NAPA COUNTY MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT

The committee met with District Manager, William Rusconi, on April 14, 1971, at the Mosquito Abatement office, 964 Imola Avenue. The office and operations buildings are located on the Napa Sanitation grounds and are under a 50-year lease from the district. The Mosquito Abatement District consists of the Manager, Mr. William Rusconi, and a five-member Board of Trustees. Their terms run for two years. The district has been in continuous operation since 1925 when it was formed under code section 2200-2398.

The annual audit was made by G. and J. Seiberlick and Company, certified public accountants, in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. The tax rate allowed the district for the fiscal year 1970-71 was \$.05 per \$100 assessed valuation compared to \$.03 the fiscal year 1969-1970. At the time of this report, the tax rate for 1971-1972 had not been established. As of June 30, 1971, the district's cash balance was \$44,138.47 compared to \$24,155.55 as of June 30, 1970. The fund balance appears sufficient to cover expenditures during the first six months until district revenues become available.

Our committee noted that the maintenance of grounds, equipment and building appears to be in excellent condition.

Mr. Rusconi and his staff are doing an outstanding job. Therefore, the committee has no recommendations at this time.
