REVIEW AND DISCUSS MEMORANDUM RECEIVED FROM DISTRICT'S LEGAL COUNSEL DATED OCTOBER 27, 2022 REGARDING BROWN ACT CHANGES

District Manager discussed several proposed changes to the current Brown Act law including but not limited to video recording and transmission, the physical participation of the quorum and requiring the justification of remote participation which is also to be limited per Assembly Bill 2449. No action taken.

REVIEW AND DISCUSS THE FEBRUARY 28, 2023 CESSATION OF CALIFORNIA'S STATE OF EMERGENCY STATUS

Per California Governor, the current exception to the Brown Act allowing teleconferences due to the local State of Emergency will cease on February 28, 2023. The Board has requested to re-agendize this item to the next regular meeting for further discussion to consider safety precautions and protocols.

QUARTERLY INVESTMENT REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 30, 2022

For the quarter ended September 30, 2022, the District earned \$2,052 in interest for the monies held with the County of Napa. The District's account held with PARS earned negative interest of -\$121,467 for the quarter ended September 30, 2022. The CalPERS OPEB account earned negative interest of -\$316,693. Information for the VCJPA Member Contingency fund was not available at the time of this meeting. No action required.
