- Member Cramer relayed complaints received from the public regarding bothersome mosquitoes.

MANAGER'S REPORT

- The District completed 61 service calls for April 2024. After the unexpected rain, all field staff continue searching for possible breeding sites throughout the County. Two new field technicians continue to learn their respective zones.
- The District Manger will continue to serve on the Local Agency Workers' Compensation Excess JPA (LAWCX) Board for another 2-year term.
- The District Manager presented the Board with the final mapping outline for the update to the District's PEIR; concluding that part 1 of the project is completed. Legal review is still pending on if an Addendum, a Supplemental EIR or both will be required.

- On May 6, 2024, House of Representative Bill 7525 was passed, defining Special Districts and clarifying that special districts are eligible to receive federal emergency financial assistance.
- The District Manager expressed concern over California's multi-billion-dollar budget deficit. Historical experience has shown large State deficits tend to result in the State taking funds from counties, cities and special districts. The Manager will update the Board as information is made available.
